

The Do's and Don'ts of Steering Gear Service & Installation



Compressed air powered grease guns have excessive pressure that push grease past the seals and into the steering gear making it inoperable



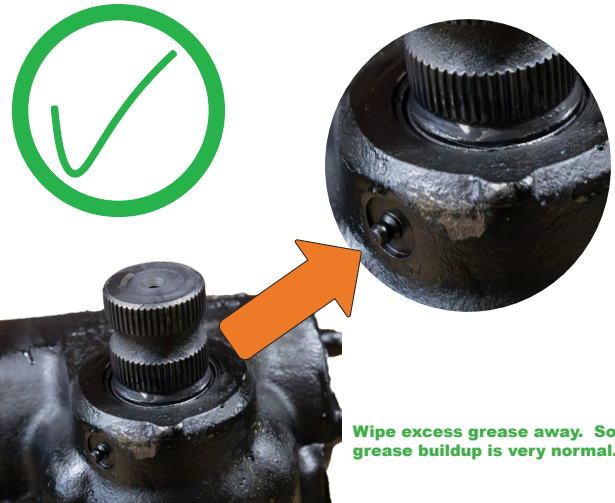
Pressure washing a steering gear will cause water to enter into the steering gear. High PSI Oil Seals do a great job at keeping the oil inside of the steering gear. They are not designed to prevent forced in water and contamination from a power washer system. Direct Contact from a power washer nozzle at a steering gear sealing area will cause a leak from the steering gear.



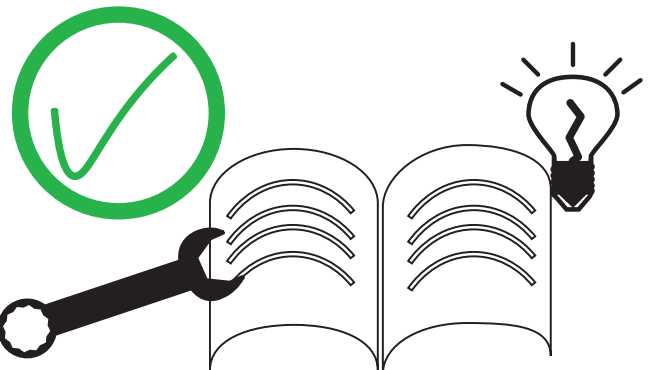
NEVER install a **USED** steering gear on a truck. It will not be properly setup for the trucks specific steering radius.



Manual grease guns ensure that pressure applied does not exceed the capacity of the seals



Wipe excess grease away. Some grease buildup is very normal.



Understand your steering gear's installation procedure for proper installation to ensure safe and reliable operation of the vehicle.
